



## Preparing for Advising Day Checklist

Blinn College's Advising Day is a half-day event designed to assist students in the transition from high school to college. All new students should attend an Advising Day to learn more about Blinn's resources, meet with an academic advisor, and register for classes.

**To get the most out of Advising Day and to register for classes, you must complete the following prior to attending:**

### REQUIRED ITEMS FOR ADVISING DAY

- Complete the Apply Texas Application: [https://www.applytexas.org/adappc/gen/c\\_start.WBX](https://www.applytexas.org/adappc/gen/c_start.WBX)
- Submit a High School Transcript (*an in-progress high school transcript will suffice until the final one can be sent*)
- Test scores for placement purposes (TSI or Official exempting test scores and documentation)

- College Transcript (you must submit a college transcript to receive credit for all college credit, including dual credit courses)
- Advising Day Registration & Payment
