ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Between

And

This agreement will become effective upon approval by the Provost of Midwestern State University and the President of Blinn College. Upon implementation, this agreement as reflected in attachments A & B will continue until one of the parties petition the other party to end the agreement.

Such petition to end this agreement: (1) must be submitted one year in advance of the intent to terminate; (2) must be submitted in writing and signed by the college president making the petition; and (3) must be delivered to the second party to the agreement. Delivery of the intent to terminate will constitute formal notification and will serve as ground for termination one year following the date of delivery.


I have enclosed an Articulation Agreement for the current catalog requirements. Please review the degree plan for accuracy. The courses we have noted as completed are requirements for your A.A.S. degree. We have listed other specific course requirements as well. It is the expectation of Midwestern State University that programs with whom we articulate are accredited by the Joint Review Committee of Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT) or are seeking this accreditation.

The agreement will allow graduates from your program to automatically receive 46 hours of Associate level Radiologic Science credit when they become a registered technologist. If the articulation agreement is not made, students entering our program may obtain this credit through an advanced placement credit exam.

Please print 2 copies of the agreement then have your President sign both copies and return both to my office along with the degree plan. Any changes you want to reflect can be made directly on the degree plan in red and emailed back to me noting those changes. Once the agreement is signed by officials from both of our schools, we will send you the final signed copy. Please call me if you have any questions. 

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ATTACHMENT A

Graduates of the AAS/Certificate Radiography program at Blinn College will be eligible for the following credit at Midwestern State University:

1. General core courses required in AAS Degree/Certificate will transfer as reflected in the degree plan in Attachment B.
2. Upon completion of 9 hours of Midwestern State University upper division Radiologic Science coursework with a "C" or above and successful completion of the ARRT exam, the student will be awarded 46 hours of block Radiologic Science transfer credit.
3. Midwestern State University will accept up to 100 hours of community college credit (to include the 46 hours of Radiologic Science block credit) towards the BSRS degree.
4. Students who received the AAS Degree/Certificate prior to the Articulation Agreement will be awarded the Radiologic Science block credit in transfer (as stated in #2 above) and the general core requirements will be evaluated upon admission.
