(5) IF student transfers 9 hours of MATH 1350/1351/1314 with a C or better in each – MATH 1314 will be used as a substitute for MATH 3381 (SHSU Course)

(6) CIEE 3374 and MATH 3381 must be completed prior to beginning Field Experience

(7) Student will apply to Educator Preparation Program during EDUC 1101

(8) C or better in SPAN 1411/1412/2311/2312 or permission of instructor required.

(9) Full acceptance to Educator Preparation Program is required prior to beginning Field Experience. Admission to Educator Preparation Program requires a minimum 2.75 Cumulative GPA or 2.75 GPA in last 60 credit hours attempted.

(10) READ 3315 or READ 3380 must be completed prior to READ 3383 and READ 3384
