Format: Progressive tee times starting off on two holes #1 & #10 paired in threesomes or foursomes depending

on the number of qualifying schools with pairings and tee times based on team and medalist scores from district tournaments on the first day and scores from round one to determine starting order for

day two.

Entry: Upon completion of the district tournament, <u>district directors</u> need to immediately fax or email a copy

of the UIL Golf District Results form to the Blinn College contact information listed above. Coaches for

teams and medalist who qualify also need to email or fax the entry form to the above

contact as well.

Fees: The fee for this tournament will be Medalist \$130.00 per player which includes coaches cart,

green fees and range balls and \$370.00 per team of five which includes green fees, range balls, and coaches cart. Meals, practice rounds, t-shirts and other expenses are the responsibility of each team/school. Please be sure that you bring your school tax form and **Tournament fees Only are**

payable to Blinn College and NOT the Brenham Country Club

Meeting: There will be a mandatory coach's meeting for the boys on Sunday, April 23 at 6:30 pm at Brenham

Country Club. Girl's coaches meeting will be on Tuesday, April 25 at 6:30 pm at the same place. At the meeting we will go over local rules, finalize pairings and tee times, answer questions, etc.

Practice: Arrangements for practice rounds are made directly through the Brenham Country

Club beginning Thursday, April 20. Practice rounds will be allowed after 2:00 pm on Saturday, April 22 and Sunday, April 23, and 1-3 pm on Monday, April 24 and Tuesday, April 25. There will not be any carts available for practice rounds on Monday and Tuesday until they start coming in from the tournament. Players may participate in only **ONE** practice round of 18 holes upon qualifying and the fee for practice rounds has been set as if walking \$ 20.00 per player not including cart fee. Regular fees apply if needing cart. Check with Club house. **Practice rounds are paid to the Brenham Country Club.**

Check-In: All players/teams are expected to check in at the golf course at least 45 minutes before their tee time

each day and should report to the starter at their first hole at least 10 minutes before their tee time

each day.

Rules: USGA rules will be used to govern this tournament except as modified by a UIL or local rule. Rules will

be reviewed and clarified at the coach's meeting on Sunday and Tuesday.

Coaches: Coaches may coach players from tee to green only. Once a player's ball is on the green coaching is no

longer allowed until after <u>ALL</u> players have completed of the hole. Only one coach is allowed to coach a team/individual once play has begun that day for the team or player. The intent of the one coach rule per team or individual is not to limit a coach from coaching but rather limit the amount of coaches per school. Penalties for coaching violations will be as follows: First Offense – Warning; Second Offense – one stroke penalty to the player and loss of coaching privileges for the coach; Third Offense -

Disqualification of the player for the entire tournament.

Ties: Individual (singles) ties shall be determined by playing additional holes until the tie is broken. The order

of holes to be played is at the discretion of the tournament committee.

Team ties shall be broken by the five players with the best scores on the final 18 holes playing additional

holes until the tie is broken. The order of holes to be played is at the discretion of the committee.

Committee: The following persons make up the Tournament Committee and serve as Rules Officials during each

round and as such may advise players as to interpretation and application of the rules. Per UIL rules,

protests of decisions made by the committee are not be permitted.
